- **ALL TOGETHER NOW**- 10:15-11:15am - All Instruments. Add fun tunes to your repertoire! Learn melody, backup and tips for bringing out the best in your playing. Dulcimer tab with standard notation & chords plus *guitar and mandolin tab*. Team taught.
- **AUTOHARP** (Beginning)-9-10am - Bring your own instrument or use a loaner. Topics covered: Autoharp basics, tuning, types of autoharps and how to play!!!! Learn a song or two with words and chords.
- **BLUE RIDGE MOUNTAIN MUSIC** -2:45-3:45pm – Learn "Blue Ridge Mountain Sky," a traditional mountain song "My Home's Across the Blue Ridge Mountains" and how to put that mountain feel on your own music. Vocal lyrics, melodies, and backup playing included. *Singers, dulcimers and all acoustic instruments* welcome. Team taught.
- **BOWED PSALTERY**-10:15-11:15am – Loaner instruments and bows available. Topics covered to help beginners - through advanced players using 2-bows.
- **DRUM & FLUTE/ ANCIENT MUSIC CIRCLE**- 2:45-3:45pm –Want to have a positive experience with music that is no work and ALL FUN? Instruments are provided, but you can bring your own. *Native American Style Flute* used.
- **GUITAR: Accompaniment** -1:30-2:30pm – Learn key factors needed to make your guitar and another instrument sound as though they are one instrument. Included: how to follow and support a lead instrument with complimentary chord progressions and leading runs, along with playing with dynamics and expression.
- **MODES, MOODS & CHOICES**-10:15-11:15am –Overview of modes in American and European folk music, and how mode suggests mood. Examine chords to a waltz and hear how they contribute to mood and character. As a group, propose, debate, and vote on our own set of chords for a melody. *Open to all instruments and vocalists*.
- **SONGS ABOUT COUNTRY FOR ALL** – 2:45-3:45pm - In honor of Veteran's Day & our veterans – a singing session with songs for our times *for all instruments and singers*. Handouts of lyrics with chords provided.
- **SINGING** – 1:30-2:30pm - Group singing workshop with a master of participation music who accompanies himself and others on fretted dulcimer/ guitar/ 5 string banjo/ harmonica/ trombone/ pocket trumpet/ and cajon!
- **SONGWRITING** – 10:15-11:15am - ASCAP award winning songwriter, shares steps and methods for creating a well crafted song: lyrics and music. Learn to start writing a song from an idea, build that idea into a complete, well-structured song, and how to rewrite until the song is all that it can and should be.
- **UKULELE TUNES & TECHNIQUES** - 9-10am – Learn a variety and styles of music that can be played on the ukulele with an assortment of chords, strums, and fingerpicking patterns. Learn Hawaii's Israel 'Iz' Kamakawiwo'ole's "Somewhere Over the Rainbow."
